| Sunday 21/04/2024 | Physics | As waves travel, they disturb the medium in which they travel in either a perpendicular direction (transverse wave) or a parallel direction (longitudinal wave). In either case, all waves share characteristics associated with their motion. In this investigation, the characteristics of frequency, wavelength, and speed will be studied. Frequency is a measure of the number of waves that pass a fixed point in an interval of time. Wavelength is a measure of the distance between equivalent points on the wave (for example, from crest to crest). The wavelength is measured in the direction of propagation of the wave. The speed is a measure of the distance a given point on a wave Reflection occurs when a wave bounces off a barrier. The law of reflection states that the angle of incidence of a wave relative to a barrier is equal to the angle of reflection of the wave relative to the barrier. In other words, this bouncing effect causes the wave to change direction, but it does not cause the wave to change speed.
